CMA is looking to hire a Bilingual (Spanish/English) Teaching Artist for an off-site community partnership program at an organization in East Harlem for families affected by Autism.

**Job Description:** Under the supervision of CMA's Director of Community Programs, the Teaching Artist will have the following responsibilities:

**Educational Responsibilities**

- Attend professional development trainings and meetings at CMA
- Co-Teach sessions for families affected by Autism
- Implement effective classroom management strategies and an organized class structure
- Cultivate and motivate students through using interdisciplinary themes and making connections to their lives and the world around them
- Encourage students to apply their observations, reflections, critical thinking, and creativity to make their own works of art
- Provide students with opportunities to interact and reflect upon artwork of their own, of their classmates, and of emerging and established artists by implementing visual thinking strategies and CMA's pedagogy of look, make, share
- Submit reflections, visual documentation, curriculum, and research on a weekly basis

**Requirements**

- Proficient in Spanish
- Experience working with students with an Autism spectrum diagnosis
- Flexible to make adaptations for diverse learners
- Outgoing, energetic, self-motivated, and passionate about art and its various contexts
- Excellent oral and written communication skills and attention to detail

**Time Commitment**

Candidates must commit one day a week on Wednesdays from November 9, 2016 – June 2017. The class is from 4:30pm – 5:30pm. One is paid for 1 hour for teaching, 1 hour for travel, and 1 hour for preparation. One must arrive to the organization in East Harlem by 3:30pm.

**Rate:** \$22 per hour for a total of 3 hours per class & 3 additional planning hours to be used as needed.
